**CHILD WELFARE**

The Child Welfare Officers of most clubs had received basic child welfare training and had attended the 'Time to Listen' course. It is stressed that it is the responsibility of Club Child Welfare Officers to make sure that relevant people in their club are CRB checked. Relevant people would include captains, vice-captains, adult scorers, umpires.

**UMPIRES**

The HCCL Umpires and Scorers Association will be running a refresher course. The course will commence on Tuesday, 9 February 2010 at 7.30 pm, held at Flockton WMC, and run by Gary Rank over 5 weeks. Please note there are no fees and no exams.

The ECB ACO Huddersfield/Halifax branch is running a Level 1 Umpires Course over 7 weeks, commencing on Monday, 15 February 2010 at 7.15 pm, held at Outlane Cricket Club. The course is free to ECB members, £10 fee for non-members. There is an exam at the end of the course. Successful candidates will receive a Level 1 certificate from the ECB.

Clubs are reminded that all umpires are now required to be members of ECB ACO to stand in the HCCL. Full details of how to become a member have been sent to the umpires as listed in last season's handbook, who are not already members. Therefore, if clubs have had a change of umpire for the coming season they must obtain the relevant paperwork from Brian Cooper, Umpires Appointment Secretary.

Clubs were also reminded that Umpires need to have undergone the CRB check to enable them to become ACO members.
