<b>Rule 1 (I)</b> <b>Add</b> at the end of the rule	<b>Page 38</b> , <i>except in section 'E'.</i>
<b>Rule 5 (F)</b> <b>Delete</b> at the end of the rule	<b>Page 41</b> <i>during May to August inclusive.</i>
<b>Rule 5 (Z)</b> <b>Amend</b> to read	<b>Page 42</b> <i>If it appears obvious that due to inclement weather, a ground will be unfit for play, then the two captains (or club representatives) can meet on the morning of the game to inspect the ground and reach a decision on the fitness of the ground. If they both agree the ground is unfit, the home club will notify the Umpires Appointments Secretary as soon as possible, but no later than 2 hours before the scheduled start of play. If the two captains (or club representatives) do not agree then both teams must turn up as normal. Any breach of this rule will result in both clubs being deducted at least 6 points.</i>
<b>Rule 6 (A)</b> <b>Amend</b> to read	<b>Page 42</b> <i>Each team shall nominate one umpire, who is a member of the ECB ACO, to act in league and cup matches (i.e. clubs with 2 teams must nominate 2 umpires).</i>
<b>Rule 6 (K)</b> <b>Amend</b> to read	<b>Page 43</b> <i>Any club failing to provide Umpire(s) for any match in accordance with the club's appointments shall receive 2 matches per team with no fine, and then a £5.00 per match fine will be imposed for the next 5 matches (3 through to 7) and then a £7.50 per match fine will be imposed for the next 5 matches (8 to 11) and then a £10.00 per match fine will be imposed on all other matches to the end of the season.</i>
<b>Rule 7 (A)</b> <b>Amend</b> to read	<b>Page 43</b> <i>All players, including juniors, must be registered with the HCCL for the club they play for.</i>
<b>Rule 8 (C)</b> <b>Add</b> at end of rule	<b>Page 46</b> <i>In addition to this, a 1 point deduction may be made from that teams overall points total.</i>
<b>Rule 9 (B)</b> <b>Amend</b> to read	<b>Page 46</b> <i>Incomplete victory (i.e. a win by virtue of runs scored) side scoring most runs, 5 points; side scoring least runs, with one or more wickets remaining, 1 point providing that in the case of the side batting first they score at a minimum of 3 runs per over OR in the case of the side batting second they score at least 75% of their opponents score. All % scores shall be rounded up to the nearest whole figure above.</i>
<b>Rule 9 (B)</b> <b>Amend</b> to read	<b>Page 46</b> <i>Incomplete victory (i.e. a win by virtue of runs scored) side scoring most runs, 5 points; side scoring least runs, 1 point subject to the total being at least 75% of the side scoring most runs.</i>

<p><b>Rule 12 (B)</b>  <b>Add</b> after the sentence beginning “The maximum points available.....”</p>	<p><b>Page 51</b>  <i>In addition to this, a further 4 points deduction may be made from that teams overall points total.</i></p>
<p><b>Rule 14 (C)</b>  <b>Delete</b> at the end of the rule</p>	<p><b>Page 53</b>  <i>The maximum price for such a tea shall be set by the League Management Board.</i></p>
<p><b>Friend Allsop Cup Rule H</b>  <b>Amend</b> to read</p>	<p><b>Page 56</b>  <i>All playing members of a club, including juniors shall be eligible to play in the competition with that club, providing the said players have played in the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> eleven for the club before 31<sup>st</sup> May or were registered with the HCCL for that club by the first match of the season. No player registered on the day of a cup game will be permitted to take part in that game.</i></p>
<p><b>Friend Allsop Cup Rule H</b>  <b>Amend</b> to read</p>	<p><b>Page 56</b>  <i>All playing members of a club (including junior members) shall be eligible to play in the competition with that club, providing the said players have played for the club before 31<sup>st</sup> May or were registered for that club by the first match of the season.</i></p>
<p><b>Friend Allsop Cup Rule A(a)</b>  <b>Amend</b> to read</p>	<p><b>Page 58</b>  <i>Each club must bowl its own ball in all rounds preceding the final. The League to provide one match ball to each club in the final.</i></p>
<p><b>Friend Allsop Cup Rule A(c)</b>  <b>Add</b> at the end of the rule</p>	<p><b>Page 58</b>  <i>at a Management Board meeting.</i></p>
<p><b>Armitage Cup Rule M</b>  <b>Amend</b> to read</p>	<p><b>Page 61</b>  <i>Each club must bowl its own ball in all rounds preceding the final. The League to provide one match ball to each club in the final.</i></p>
<p><b>New Rule – Fixtures</b></p>	<p><i>Any team failing to fulfil a fixture, other than due to inclement weather, to have the available points from the match deducted.</i></p>
<p><b>New Rule</b></p>	<p><i>The Management Board to convene a sub-committee to investigate assessment of umpires with a view to a report being made to the 2010 AGM. This sub-committee should consist of the Management Board, representatives from clubs and members of the umpires association. Its brief should be to formulate a simple system which would help identify umpires’ training needs and any other feasible uses.</i></p>
